**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

**PROCLAIMING
NOVEMBER 2004 AS
“FAMILY CAREGIVERS’ MONTH”**

Whereas, November 2004, has been designated by the National Family Caregivers’ Association as **“NATIONAL FAMILY CAREGIVERS’ MONTH”** and we join with the nation in recognizing and celebrating the devotion, commitment, and hard work of all family caregivers in Sacramento County including 11,500 In-Home Supportive Services family caregivers.

Whereas, to celebrate **“NATIONAL FAMILY CAREGIVERS’ MONTH”** the Sacramento County In-Home Supportive Services Public Authority and the IHSS Advisory Committee acknowledge and honor all 15,750 family and non-family In-Home Supportive Services caregivers who are dedicated home care professionals in Sacramento County; and

Whereas, **“FAMILY CAREGIVERS’ MONTH”** provides the Sacramento County In-Home Supportive Service Public Authority and the IHSS Advisory Committee with an opportunity to reflect on the achievements that have improved the delivery of services provided by the In-Home Supportive Service program successfully allowing the consumers to remain safely in their own homes; and

Whereas, **“FAMILY CAREGIVERS’ MONTH”** is a time to promote increased awareness about specific issues and concerns for caregivers and consumers within the diverse population; and

Whereas, the Sacramento County In-Home Supportive Services Public Authority with the advice and support of the In-Home Supportive Services Advisory Committee, continues to develop and implement strategies to provide caregiver education and training; to improve caregiver benefits and wages; and to reduce barriers and improve linkages to resources and services through community collaboration for all in-home caregivers in Sacramento County; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Supervisors, County of Sacramento, State of California, hereby proclaim November 2004 as **“FAMILY CAREGIVERS’ MONTH”** in Sacramento County, California.
