State Budget Update #3

Legislative Budget Committees Complete Work

The Senate and Assembly Budget Committees approved their respective versions of the 2016-17 budget this week, with the Senate Budget Committee closing out on Tuesday and the Assembly Budget Committee taking its final votes this morning. Issues where the two houses took different actions will go to the Budget Conference Committee for resolution. The Budget Conference Committee reconciles the differences in the two houses' versions of the budget to arrive at the Legislature's final budget, which will be sent to the Governor for his signature, likely in mid-June. The start date and members of the Budget Conference Committee have not yet been announced. We anticipate that Budget Conference Committee hearings will start mid- to late-next week.

Attached is a [chart](#) that displays the actions of each house on the health and human services issues that we have been tracking. The issues in bold on the [chart](#) are those where the Budget Committees in each house took different actions. Those issues will be going to the Budget Conference Committee. Of those health and human services issues in Conference, of particular note are the following priorities:

- Funding for actual social worker costs of RFA implementation under CCR.
- APS training.
- Bridge child care for foster youth.
- Bringing Families Home Program
